Dear Mr. Singleton,

Thank you for your letter dated October 4, 2013. In your letter you advised that any improvements to the Fairview Park should include a Mitigation Monitoring Plan consistent with CA Public Resources Code Section 21083.2 that meets the standards of CEQA Guidelines Section 1506.5 requiring careful documentation and analysis of archaeological items. This mitigation monitoring was recommended for most recently approved project "Entry Way Concept Plan."

Please note that the Mitigated Negative Declaration for Master Plan of the Fairview Park include such measures that will be adhered to during construction.

In addition, the City is in the process of updating the General Plan. At the beginning of the process, we contacted your office and letters were sent to the list of all American Indian Tribes in the area. Per Government Code Section 65352.3, the tribes will be notified again once the draft Environmental Impact Report for the general plan is available.

We appreciate your recommendation and thank you for the input.
