

CODE ENFORCEMENT

190 Block of 17th: Report received of transient sleeping in front of business. **Report forwarded to PD. This is private property and property owner will be notified.**

600 Block of Baker: Follow up check on problem property. **During a check on a business property boarded up due to previous issues with transients taking over vacant units, a male transient was observed exiting a boarded up unit. Property has onsite security but none observed during the incident. This is private property and property owner is reluctant to call PD and sign for arrests for trespassing. Owner notified of incident.**

600 Block of Terminal Way: Observed transients camping at two different locations on private property. **Contacted female transient who was packing to clear the area. Interviewed to determine possible outreach needs. Female given Outreach contact info. Contacted male transient nearby and also interviewed to determine possible outreach needs. Male given Outreach contact info. Both cleared the area.**

2800 Block of Mesa Verde: Report of possible transients camping in vacant units. **Visited property, spoke with contractor working at the property and was told transients are observed walking around the property and people sleeping in a vehicle parked overnight. Observed and noted vehicle possibly used for sleeping. Property owner to be notified.**

3000 Block of Bristol: Observed male transient camping on posted private property. **Male has been contact at this location previously. Male made aware of the private property postings and cleared the area. Each time contacted the male claims to be going into recovery.**

1100 Block of Victoria: Report of transient camping on private business property. **Visited location and contacted male transient packing personal items to clear the area. Male made aware of complaint and said he would clear the location.**

2000 Block of Harbor: Reports of transients camping on private business property. **Visited location and contacted 3 transients camping. Made all aware of complaint and that it was private property. All said they would clean the area and leave.**

3000 Block of College Ave: Reports of people living in vehicles. **Visited location and observed vehicle parked at same location for a few days and had evidence of someone living inside. Woke vehicle owner up and interviewed. Owner made aware of restrictions of vehicle living. Owner said he would clear the area.**

Welfare checks and contacts: Total of 15 checks were performed. All were informed of Outreach help and offered Outreach contact information. Seven declined help, 2 currently working with Outreach, 6 requested Outreach information, 4 of the six did not attend meeting with Outreach.

OUTREACH

Linkage Housing Resources

Housing Match: Client matched for housing, met with their housing provider to do paperwork.

Housing Match: Outreach received confirmation from nonprofit provider that 2 chronically homeless clients have been approved for a 2-bedroom unit. Move in date will be issued within 1-2 weeks

Housing Match: Outreach was contacted by Orange County Housing Authority to schedule Shelter Plus Care initial housing interview for senior disabled client.

Housing Match: Outreach met with chronic client at his housing interview with a local housing provider in Fullerton.

Housing Assessment: Outreach met client at library to update her housing assessment, and client subsequently scored higher on the assessment. Outreach will work with client to get her connected to affordable housing resources.

Housing Assessment: Outreach did a housing assessment on a client living in his car. Client's scores qualified him for permanent supportive housing.

Reconnection Services

Long term chronically homeless client met Outreach for an intake. Client is interested in a reconnection back to her hometown. Outreach will follow up with client and provide reconnection services.

Outreach met a non-resident client at the Lighthouse Church. Client requested to be reconnected to his hometown. Client successfully passed the background check. Outreach will follow up with client to discuss the next steps.

Outreach contacted shelter in Wyoming and spoke with case manager who confirmed non-resident could stay there once he arrived at his destination. Outreach sent over bus ticket information to Trellis for purchase.

Linkage Employment

Community Impact Team began their new Open Gate International culinary training program where 13 homeless participants signed up and 12 showed up for classes at the Hood Kitchen Space in Costa Mesa. The program is sponsored by the wife of professional baseball player, Albert Pujols.
