

CODE ENFORCEMENT

3000 Block of Bristol: Report received of transient camp on private property. **Visited location, observed items stored in bushes. Spoke with owner who reported transients camping and being aggressive when asked to remove items from the property. Owner given suggestions re: deterrents and rights as property owner. PD made aware.**

3100 Block of College Ave: Reports/observations of vehicle camping. **Contacted male camping in vehicle. Made male aware of regulations of camping in vehicle, male cleared the area. On-going issues in this location with vehicle camping.**

600 Block of Baker St: Inspection conducted on property previously taken over by transient squatters. **Property maintenance issues repaired but owner must do more to prevent trespassers.**

Delhi Channel: Observed transient camp/multiple areas with graffiti. **New transient camp set up and new graffiti along flood channel. OC Public Works notified.**

Welfare checks and contacts: Total of 2 checks were performed. All were informed of Outreach help and offered Outreach contact information. One currently working with Outreach, other person took information.

Dublin/Watson Ave. Area: Report of in-op vehicle possibly used for camping. **Investigated and observed vehicle with 4 flat tires and expired tags. Vehicle not registered in Costa Mesa. Reported to PD and vehicle towed away.**

700 Block of Wilson: Report received of transient camping on private property. **Known male transient observed camping at the location and contacted. Male made aware of the complaint and of the location being private property. Male exhibited evidence of medical issues with his legs but declined medical aid and Outreach help/information. Male cleared the area.**

3100 Block of Harbor: Report received of aggressive transient on business private property. **Spoke with manager who reported female transient harassing customers as they left the business. Description fits known female transient. Business to call PD in the future.**

500 Block of Hamilton: Report received of transients defecating on private property. **Spoke to business owner and offered suggestions regarding possible deterrents. Owner to implement.**

600 Block of Terminal Way: Received report of transients camping on private/posted property and leaving trash, syringes and evidence of illegal drugs. **Spoke with manager and directed them to call PD to collect the drugs left behind. Owner to check area more frequently in the morning hours and call PD when needed.**

Welfare checks and contacts: Total of 4 checks were performed. All were informed of Outreach help and offered Outreach contact information. One currently working with Outreach, one person took information, two person declined Outreach help/information/medical aid.

OUTREACH

Emergency Housing

Outreach placed resident client in a motel until client receives scheduled medical treatment.

Housed

Temporarily Housed: Outreach has temporarily housed one resident and one non-resident client.

Outreach Housed: Outreach has successfully housed 5 resident clients with the assistance of community housing agency partners.

Linkage Permanent Housing Assessment

Outreach administered two permanent housing assessments to non-resident clients.

Linkage Housing Resources

Outreach met with resident client at housing appointment with community partner to discuss client's progress.

Outreach was informed that two resident clients have been matched for housing.

New Clients

New client who currently resides at local church met with Outreach seeking employment assistance. Client currently suffers from mental health issues and is originally from San Diego. Outreach will follow up with client and provide employment resources.

New client who currently resides in his vehicle met with Outreach for general assistance. Outreach will follow up with client and provide community linkages and referrals as needed.

New client met with Outreach seeking housing assistance. Client previously lost his job and is currently addicted to illegal substances. Outreach will follow up with client and provide housing resources and linkages as needed.

Contact

Outreach was informed that resident client has been hospitalized. Outreach arranged for housing provider to meet with client at hospital to discuss housing placement.

Linkage Mental Health

Outreach and OC Mental Health performed wellness checks on two resident clients.

Outreach and OC Mental Health met with three resident clients and two non-resident clients and linked them to county mental health services.

Outreach linked resident client to SOS for mental health evaluation services.

OC Mental Health linked non-resident client to county detoxification services.

Outreach, Newport Beach Police, and resident client met at client's mental health appointment.

Linkage Social Services

Outreach met resident client at Social Security office to get award letter.

Outreach linked resident client to Social Services for general assistance.

Outreach linked resident client to Social Services and was informed that client is eligible for temporary housing.

Outreach was informed that resident client has received his award letter stating his benefits will be dispersed next month.

Linkage Medical

Outreach assisted resident client in re-scheduling medical appointment.

Outreach assisted client in receiving medication for contagious disease.

Outreach linked two resident clients to SOS medical services for appointment with Licensed Clinical Social Worker.

Linkage Documentation

Outreach provided resident client with a free identification form.

Outreach provided resident client with resources for veteran assistance programs and employment services.

Linkage Job Connection

Outreach was informed that resident client has been hired by local culinary company.
